

# Babylon Summer Exhibition 2016

Saturday 9 July – Sunday 21 August 2016

Our Second Summer Exhibition will display works in a variety of mediums and genres by any artist of any age, professional and amateur. Over the 5 weeks it's a chance for visitors to browse, buy and discuss the works on show. This year the exhibition will be broadly themed 'Ely Cathedral : Ship of the Fens', whether you depict the building, the Fen landscape, or the people, we want to see your take on our beautiful iconic building. We are looking for original, contemporary work – entry is open to all and will be selected on its merit, all work must be for sale.

The works will be selected and hung by the Gallery.

Artists may enter a maximum of 3 pieces, there is a non-refundable entry fee of £10 (incl VAT) per piece, the proceeds go towards supporting our charity ADEC and our diverse programme of events and exhibitions. Additional prints and artists cards of original work may be considered to sale at commission only. If your work sells you may replace it with another piece with no additional fee.

*(Please note : entry fees are non-refundable and do not guarantee selection, if you are not selected your fee will be used to support the work of ADeC charity no. 1043197).*

Digital or photographic submission to the 2016 Summer Exhibition

For our selection process, artists must submit photographs of their work (with dimensions) to us with their application form and fee, to the Babylon Gallery, Waterside, Ely, CB7 4AU.

The judges will select up to 200 entries to be exhibited during the show.

During the summer our riverside gallery is an unrivalled local setting for artists to display and sell their artworks.

For all of the works displayed, the artist is the seller of the work and the Gallery will take a 30% + vat commission on all sales.

Our aim is to fill the gallery with artwork hung from ceiling to floor, we want as many entries as possible.
