Ely Cinema is under threat and we need to raise at least £17,000 over the next year to ensure its survival.

Ely Cinema is valued by the community; it provides a unique cinema experience on the riverside and is supported by fantastic volunteers.

Alongside many high street and small independent traders we have seen some of the toughest trading in the UK for years. This together with more competition from the out of town national chain has meant a gradual decline of our audiences. Over the last two years the charity has increasingly had to subsidise the running costs of the cinema which is clearly not sustainable in the long term. In a few months our Board will be facing the difficult decision to close it permanently.

To help ensure its survival we're initially seeking 30 people to pledge £100 each to a cinema fund by 1st June; to help pay for the projector warranty and maintenance.

Terms and Conditions

By making a pledge or donation you agree to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. By pledging a donation towards the Save Our Cinema appeal, you agree to pay Arts Development in East Cambridgeshire (trading as Babylon ARTS) the sum agreed, only if Babylon ARTS raise at least £3000 in pledges by 9am on 1st June 2019.
- 2. Should the target be reached, you agree to pay the sum stated in your pledge, by 15th June 2019 by bank transfer, cheque or cash.
- 3. You agree that the donation will be used towards the cost of the warranty and maintenance of the Ely Cinema Projector and that no change will be given if the cost should be lower than expected.
- 4. You agree that any money raised over and above £3000 can be used by Babylon ARTS, as a registered charity, towards the costs of running Ely Cinema, however it sees fit.
- 5. By accepting your donation Babylon ARTS agrees to use the donation for the purposes for which it was given. This does not guarantee that Ely Cinema will remain an active entity, and puts no obligation on Babylon ARTS to continue to provide the Ely Cinema on an ongoing basis.
- 6. By making a donation to Babylon ARTS, you understand that you will not receive any personal benefits in association with the donation.
- 7. By making a small donation under £30 you agree that Babylon ARTs can use the funds to support its charitable objectives however it sees fit, whether or not the Cinema remains a going concern.
- 8. All requests for refunds of donations should be made by the donor to office@babylonarts.org.uk. Refunds of donations are made in accordance with the UK Charities Act 2011 and the Fundraising Regulator Code of Fundraising Practice. Refund requests must be made within 7 days of the donation being made in order to be accepted. It can take up to 10 working days for refund to appear back in your bank account. Should a refund be processed which affects a match funding campaign, the Babylon ARTS reserves the right in its sole and absolute discretion to reallocate any match funds secured.
